City of Kerkhoven Garbage Services

The City has a garbage truck with an automatic arm. This arm will retrieve cans that are placed on the curb, dump the refuse into the truck, and return the can to the curb. Every household will be required to have a City issued garbage container, and will be able to choose from one of 2 different sizes, a 65 gallon or 95 gallon container.

Your residence should already have a City issued garbage container. If there is not a garbage container, please contact the City Office to arrange for a garbage can drop off. All refuse must be placed in one of these cans. Excess outside of the garbage container will charged the following fees: \$10.00 for the driver to leave the vehicle and \$5.00 per bag picked up. Garbage placed in privately owned containers will not be collected. No trash will be picked up unless it is in one of the city-owned cans. All Garbage Cans must be removed from the curb AFTER trash has been picked up.

<u>These cans will be the property of the City of Kerkhoven.</u> They will be hot stamped with a serial number that will be kept on record at City Hall. The homeowner will be responsible for lost, stolen or purposely damaged cans.

Recycling is a service that is ran through the Swift County Environmental services. Recycling is picked up on Mondays and must be placed in a blue recycling container or other container marked as recycling. **DO NOT PLACE YOUR RECYCLE CONTAINER ALONGSIDE YOUR GARBAGE CAN.** Please contact the City Office if you need a blue recycling container. The cost of a new recycling container is \$15.00.
